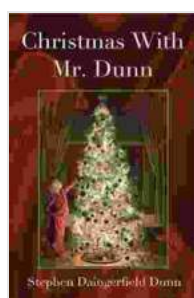

"This is for you, my dear," he said. "Merry Christmas."

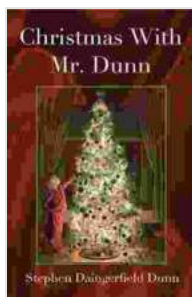
