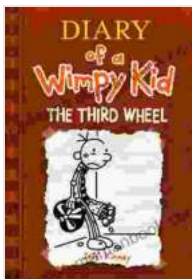


The Third Wheel Diary: A Hilarious Journey Through the Awkwardness of Middle School

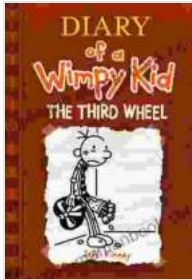

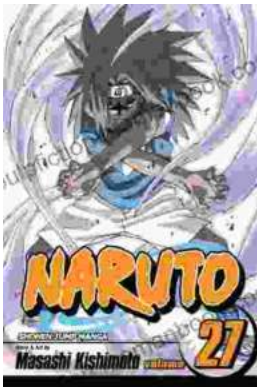
